A PHYSICIAN'S PRAYER

Dr. Paul Puthuran Medical Superintendent, Lourdes Hospital

A famous Chinese physician Huang Niching in 3000 BC graded the merits of a physician in one of the oldest medical records as

"the superior doctor is the one who prevents disease, the mediocre doctor treats before the disease worsens and the most inferior doctor treats the full blown disease."

The convergence of technologies and the availability of technological advancements have taken the diagnostic capabilities to a different plain hitherto unknown to the medical professional. However all these advancements, devices and systems should be affordable and accessible to the common man. The western model should not be copied in toto as each country and state has unique features inherent to itself. The level of sanitation. nutrional status, educational background and lifestyle pattern determine the disease distribution.

Hence a judicious application of the system should be implemented. A holistic approach is required, taking into consideration the physical, emotional, psychological, social and

spiritual needs, most importantly, at an affordable cost. It should be patient-centric region specific and nation oriented. It should not be ready-made but custom made. After all, one shoe does not fit all!

Are we deviating from the principles underlying in the Chinese wisdom? Are we practicing preventive medicine or defensive medicine? Here I have a plea to the media – the reporting has to be factual and authentic instead of sensationalizing thereby creating panic in the community.

The following prayer is an adaptation and a modified version of an oath for cancer patients offered by Dr A.P.J. Abdul Kalam. May I call it a Physician's prayer...

- I love my medical profession as a noble mission.
- I will try to be a life-long learner, I will practice what I learn and impart what I learnt to my junior colleagues.
- I will indulge in quality care with high standards irrespective of who I am treating.
- I will not introduce any diagnostic pain.

- I will work with integrity and succeed with integrity.
- I will not deny my pattents any information regarding the diagnosis and prognosis.
- I will not indulge in unethical practices for my personal gain.
- I will always consider myself as an instrument in the Hands of the Almighty.
- I will include the patient's family and well-wishers in the medical delivery system.
- I will practice a holistic approach in dealing with my patients with regard to their physicial, emotional and social needs.

When you are inspired by some great purpose, all your thoughts break their bounds. Your mind transcends limitations, your consciousness expands in every direction and you find yourself in a new great and wonderful world. Dormant forces and talents come alive and you discover yourself to be a greater person by far than you ever dreamt yourself to be and in this context, you become a superior doctor.

UNICEF declares Lourdes Hospital as a "Baby Friendly Hospital". Lourdes becomes a training center for other hospitals leading to Kochi becoming the first Baby Friendly city in the world in 1994.



January 1996

First CT scan inaugurated by the then Chief Minister Mr. A.K. Anthony.

August 1999

Inauguration of the first Gamma Imaging Center a full fledged Department of Nuclear Medicine for the first time in Kerala in Lourdes Hospital by Sukhdev Singh Kang, the then Governor of Kerala.





August 2000

Inauguration of Kristu Jayanti Hospital, a 100 bedded satellite center of Lourdes Hospital, at Perumbilly by the then Minister for Health and Sports Mr. V.C. Kabir.



March 2003

Inauguration of Sidhi Sadan-Lourdes College of Nursing at Kakkanad.

May 2004

Dental department expanded to include four subspecialties.

August 2006

First foot to hand bone transplant done successfully by the Department of Orthopedics.

October 2006

First full mouth flap surgery done in one sitting successfully in the Dental Department.



March 2007

Inauguration of Lourdes Heart Institute and Neuro Center by the then Defence Minister, Mr. A.K. Anthony.

March 2007

First cardiac bypass surgery done in Lourdes Hospital.



March 2007

1st Biplane digital Cath-lab with Flat Pannel Detector in South East Asia installed.

June 2007

Insulin pump used successfully for the first time to treat elderly pregnant lady with uncontrolled diabetes by Department of General Medicine.

December 2007

1st knee replacement done successfully in Lourdes Hospital.

February 2008

Lourdes Institute of Behavorial Sciences started with team of doctors, clinical psychologists and other supporting staff.

August 2008

1st artificial cartilage transplant for joints in South India by Department of Orthopedics.

March 2009

1st total ankle replacement in India.

January 2009

1st Pediatric ENT clinic started in Kerala.

February 2009

Empanelment of Lourdes Hospital with Employee State insurance Corporation.

March 2009

First congenital heart disease treated with interventional cardiac surgical technique (Percutaneous device closure of PDA).

May 2010

WHO and UNICEF awards Lourdes Hospital the "Baby Friendly Hospital Initiative" certificate.

June 2010

First minimally invasive cardiac valve surgery done successfully in Kerala.

November 2010

Lourdes Hospital approved by the American Heart Association as an International Training Center for Basic and Advanced Cardiac Life Support courses.

January 2011

Empanelment of Lourdes Hospital for receiving the Prime Minister's Relief Fund.

April 2011

First minimally invasive cardiac bypass surgery done successfully.



August 2011

9th and 10th Intensive Care Units opened with 25 beds.



August 2011

MRI Scanning Unit inaugurated by Chief Minister Mr. Oomen Chandy.



January 2012

Advanced micro-surgical operating system obtained for Plastic and Reconstructive Microsurgery.



June 2012

Botox clinic started for patients suffering for Neurological Disorders like Dystonia, spasticity etc.


